- 51 March 18, 1944 ³⁴¹ No. 1 - Germany - Turned back at Ger. Border - Crossed France alone - 91 flak holes. ^{8ARRITZ}
- 53 March 27, 1944 ⁴⁰⁴ No. 2 - France - Hit target - Landed at R.A.F. base, weather. ^{NOBALL}
- 54 April 5, 1944 ⁴⁰⁴ No. 3 - France - Bombs not dropped, weather. ^{BOURGEOIS}
- 54 April 10, 1944 ⁴⁰⁴ No. 4 - France - Hit Target - No flak, fighters. ^{OSCHERSLEBEN}
- 54 April 11, 1944 ⁶⁹² No. 5 - Germany - Hit Target - Fighters - Saw 2 B-24's & 1 enemy fighter go down. ^{PAPERBOREY} (AIR MEDAL)
- 53 April 19, 1944 No. 6 - Germany - Missed Target - No Fighters - Little flak.
- April 22, 1944 Lt. Couch killed - Fighters followed formation to base after dark.
- April 25, 1944 One Wagner - flying sub with Lt. Combs - missing in action.
- 51 April 29, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 7 - Germany - Hit Target - Three attacks by fighters - (Got one) ^{BERLIN}
- 51 April 29, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 8 - NOBALL - FRANCE - Bombs NOT DROPPED
- 51 May 1, 1944 No. 9 - LIEGE, BELGIUM - Bombs NOT DROPPED Heavy flak on both targets.
- May 2, 1944 - Capt Knight presented my Air Medal to me (Cluster to a. m.)
- 51 May 5, 1944 ⁰⁹⁵ No. 10 - ??? Brunswick, Germany - [Recall] ^{OSNABRUCK}

- 51 May 13, 1944 ¹⁶³ No. 12 - Germany - Cloudy over target - 1st section did not drop. ^{Brunswick}
- 51 May 19, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 13 - Germany - Hit Target - Saw fighters, but none attacked us. ^{REIMS}
- 51 May 20, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 14 - France - Hit Target - Light flak - No fighters. ^{BOURGES} (Cluster to a. m.)
- 51 May 23, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 15 - France - Hit Target - No flak or fighters ^{MULHOUSE}
- 51 May 25, 1944 ⁰⁰⁵ No. 16 - France - Hit Target - No flak or fighters ^{NEUNKIRCHEN}
