SUBJECT: Abortion Report

TO: Air Executive, 458th Bombardment Group (H), AAF 123, APO 558 (THRU: Group Engineering)

- 1. B 24J Airplane #42-50502 piloted by 1st Lt L.S. HAYNES, of the 752nd Bombardment Squadron (H), aborted from the mission of 15 March 1945 when over the Zuider Zee.
- 2. Pilot reported that while attempting to increase his power settings the epressure on #4 engine dropped to 26". Amplifiers were changed but pressure remained at 26". Shortly afterwards #3 turbo ran away and had to be controlle d with the throttle.
- 3. At inspection it was found that the ball and socket joint between the exhaust collector ring and the tail pipe of #4 engine had dropped out of position allowing the exhaust gas to escape without passing through the supercharger turbine wheel. #3 waste gate motor was found to be inoperative keeping the waste gate jammed in the closed position.
