458th BOMB GROUP SPECIAL INTRUDER ACTION REPORT MISSION 22 APRIL 44

- 1. 458th Bombardment group (H) AAF 123
- A. One JU-88 and one ME-110
 - B. Each of above E/a made one pass.
- 3. At 2210 hours 22 April 1944 while formation was approximately at a a

4. same flight of three a/c was attacked by each XXX e/a.

5. E/A swooped out of darkness across flight and away.

6. Commanding Officer of Station from Flight Control Tower ordered formation to fly northwest for 20 minutes. during ensuing 40 minute flight no further E/A were encountered.

When Flight Control received plot from Division warning "bandits" was sent out on Channel A, station KKK and darky frequencies. This was received by our A/C.

8. Two A/C were hit by E/A gunfire. one crashed in flames, other forced to make crash landing. Category of damage in each case is salvage. At least seventeen (17) holes from 20mm shells and numerous 30 cal holes are discernable in wrec kage of crash landed A/C.

9. No A/C were damaged on ground.

- 10. see # 8 above. surviving personnel attribute loss of A/C directly to E/A intruder fire.
- 11. A. Personnel casualties among crews of two A/C hit by E/A: nine killed, five wounded.

B. None

- C. Impossible to determine in case of crashed A/C so included in "A".
- 12. Crash landed A/C was brought down safely although #'s 3 and 4 engines were shot out and one of remaining props ran away.
