On 23 September 1944, in A/C 952, on a trucking mission from AAF 123, to A-71, I made a normal approach and landing. Immediately efter landing the right wing dropped, and I thought the right tire was flat. I tried to hold A/C on runway with right throutle, and left brake and rudder. At about 5c-70 MMH the wing dropped enough to make me realize it was main landing sear feilure. The A/C left the runway, and skidded to a stop in the greas, after hitting a P-51 A/C, truck and two jeeps. Injuries were minor and were treated immediately at A-71. The A/C did not burn, but was a total loss.
