a. Date of Mission - 20 April 1944

b. Primary Target -

20th Combat Wing 93rd Bomb Group - Yvrench/Bois 446th Bomb Group - Flexecourt/Domart 448th Bomb Group - Bonnieres

- e. Units Participating 20th CBW (93rd, 446th, 448th BG) 96th CBW (458th, 467th, 466th BG) 2nd CBW (453rd, 445th, 389th BG) 14th CBW (392nd, 44th BG)

2. Narrative

- a. Four Combat Wings dispatched 212 aircraft from eleven Groups to attack the Noball targets at Yvrench/Bois Carre, Flexecourt/Domart, Bonnieres, Siracourt, Wizernes and Marquis-Mimoyecque. Excellent fighter support was given by five Groups of P-47's and two Groups of P-38's.
- b. Assemblies were accomplished without incident and the routes to and from the target were flown as briefed.
- c. The 2nd Combat Wing attacked Wizernes with fair results; one Squadron of the 453rd Bomb Group was unable to pick up the target and did not bomb. Clouds in the target area at Siracourt prevented the 96th Combat Ving from bombing and one Squadron dropped on Isbergues, believing it to be Siracourt, with poor results. The 14th Combat Wing found its target, Marquis-Mimoyecque, completely covered by cloud and did not bomb. One Squadron of the 392nd Group picked up the target through a small opening and bombed with unobserved results. Bonnieres, the target of the 448th Bomb Group, was cloud covered and only two flights could bomb, results being poor. The 93rd Bomb Group attacked Yvrench/Bois Carre with poor results. The 446th Group attacked Flexecourt with fair results.
- d. Flak was moderate to intense and accurate in the target area and accounted for our two losses. There were no enemy aircraft attacks.



- a. The assigned primary targets for this visual mission were Flixicourt, Yvrench/Pois, Ponnieres, Biracourt, Wizernes, and Marquis.
- b. Yvrench/Bois wer attacked by one Group in four elements, the first element making two runs. Flixicourt was attacked in four elements, the first element making three runs due to cloud. Bonniers was attacked by two elements of one Group. Isbergues was attacked because of faulty target identification. Two Groups and one Squadron attacked Wizernes. One Squadron make two runs and attacked Marquis.
- c. Two Groups did not bomb due to clouds. One Squadron was off course and did not bomb. One flight failed to bomb because the load was shot down and another flight failed to bomb due to clouds. One flight leader had his bombsight freeze and dropped on a preceling flight.

3. Anti-A rcraft Fire.

- a. Meager to moderate and accurate predictor control fire was encountered at Target No. 39.
- b. No AA was encountered at Target No. 85.
- Meager to moderate and accurate predictor control fire was encountered at Target No. 36.
- d. Moderate and accurate predictor control fire was encountered at Turget No. 7. Gunfire was encountered almost continuously from Abbeville to the target.
- e. Moderate and accurate predictor control fire was encountered at Target No. 5.
- f. Moderate to intense and accurate predictor control fire was encountered at Target No. 9.
- g. Moderate and accurate gunfire was also encountered at Abbeville, Oisement, Dieppe, Neufchatel, Amions, St. Ouen and Colais. Rockets leaving smoke trails were seen at Lo Treport.
- h. One A/C was shot down near St. Ouch at 19,000 ft, and the other missing A/C is believed to have been shot down at St. Omer at approximately 19,000 ft.
