- a. Date of Mission 20 June 1944.
- b. Primary Targets

2nd Combat Wing - Authors, St. Martin L'Hortier, Fienvilliers.

95th Combat Wing - Bachimont, Regnauville, Fleury, Crepy, Feifs, Enguinno-Gatte.

96th Combat Wing - St. Martin L'Hortier, Oisemont.

- e. Units Participating 2nd CDW (309th; 445th, 453rd DG).

#### 2. Marrative.

- a. 143 aircraft were dispatched in twelve Squadrons, each led by a CH aircraft, to attack ten Meball targets in the Pas de Calais area. One Group of P-47s provided fighter support.
- b. Assorblies were accomplished without incident and the briefed route was generally flown.
- c. The assigned targets were attacked on GH with the following results, shown by strike attack verticals: Pienvilliers excellent, Fleury very good; Authoux, Regnauville and Foifs good; St. Hartin and Cropy fair; and Bachimont and Enguinne-Gatte poor. Oisement was attacked on GH with unobserved results.
- d. Moderate gunfire was encountered at St. Pol; Montdidier, Abbeville, Lille, Oisemont, Dieppe, the Coxyde/Furnes area, Dunkirk, Meupert, Berck sur Mer and St. Oner. Meager AA fire was encountered at Ardens, Hesdin, Siracourt, Authoux, Lens, Arras, Achiet, Le Treport and Viville sur Mer. Me cray sireraft were encountered and fighter support was good. One sireraft was lost to ency AA fire. Claims were mil.

#### 3. Anti-Aircraft Fire.


- Bachimont Crepy a. Targets -Regnauville Fiefs Fleury St. Martin L'Hortier Fienvillers (11)Wisernes Oisemont Siracourt Autheux Berlin Enguinne-Gatte abortive
- b. (1) Moderate gunfire was encountered at St. Pol, Montdidier, Ableville, Lille, Oisemont, Dieppe, the Coxyde/Furnes area, Dunkirk, Nieuport, Berck sur Mer and St. Omer.
  - (2) Meager sunfire was encountered at Amiens, Hesdin, Siracourt, Autheux, Lens, Arras, Achiet, Le Treport, and Biville sur Mer.
  - (3) Rockets were seen at various places, a concentration of approximately 18 being seen at 5018N-0200E.
  - (4) One A/C of the 445th Group was shot down at 21,000 ft in the vicinity of St. Martin L'Hortier, probably by the Montdidier defenses.
  - (5) One A/C of the 489th Group was badly damaged by AA fire in the vicinity of Autheux and eventually crashed near the enemy coast.

## ENEMY AIRCRAFT OPPOSITION

1. NO E/A ENCOUNTERED.

## ANTI-AIRCRAFT FIRE

2. IN THE TARGET AREA AND ON THE BOMB RUN THE FORMATION ENCOUNTERED INTENSE AND ACCURATE FLAK OF THE CF VARIETY. AT ARRAS THE FLAK WAS MODERATE BUT ACCUARTE OF THE CF VARIETY. TWENTY FOUR ROCKETS WERE FIRED FROM THE LEFT OF THE TARGET AND SEVERAL SCARECROW AND STREAMERS WERE ALSO OBSERVED. ALL SIX A/C OF THE FORMATION SUFFERED MINOR BATTLE DAMAGE.

3. A 10/10THS UNDERCAST PREVENTED ANY OBSERVATIONS BEING REPORTED.
