At about 0930 on 29 Jum Ah while on the bumbing rum attacking ASCHRESLERN, we received several flak hits, one of which started a fire in the Filet's oxygen system and spread over the left side of the ockpit. The CO2 Fire Extinguisher was used but did no goods. The fire was getting worse and it appeared that we would be unable to get it out so the signal was given to prepare to cheaden ship. The interphone system was out and the alarm bells in the tail and on the filight deak did not work and it is not known whether the bell in the nose compariment worked or not. We continued to work on the fire and finally managed to best it out. At this point the Engineer made an inspection of the ship to see if there were any further damage or injuries to personnel. It wasn't until them that we found out that the Markgator and Mose Turret gumer had belied out. The wasts gumers saw the two parachutes open but did not realize at the time who it wasny. The rest of the oraw was uninjured and returned with the ship to the bear safely.

In reply to your questions concerning air orew members S/Sgt James J. Fitzpatrick, S/Sgt David C. Hunter, Sgt. James R. Murray, S/Sgt. George Mack, T/Sgt Edward J. Murphy, F/O Horman L. Lakey, let Lt. Memneth M. Gorrell

At the time I was shot-down over Germany, August 9th, 1944, I was not flying with this crew. The reference made to the above crew must be of a mission I flew with this crew in June or July of 1944 to Asohoralebea, Gormany. On that mission we were badly shot-up by flak. The pilots oxygen control box was struck by a piece of flak, and the resulting flames that eveleoped the flight deck, plus the confusion and increased amount of altitude we were losing, influenced the nose-turret guner Sit, James R. Murray 35274255, and our navigator 2nd 14. Feldman, to ball-out. However, the pilot, engineer, and myself, succeeded in extinguishing the flames, and we made it back to our base in England, without our nose turret man and navigator. This action all occured over the target, Aschersleben, Germany. We were all members of the 752nd SQL, 458th Romb. GF., 8th Air Force.
